Your school's options for funding tuition

Over and above your usual school budget, you have the following supplementary options to fund Third Space Learning:



National Tutoring Programme funding

Ring-fenced grant funding allocated directly to schools for in-school tutoring.



Pupil Premium

Per-pupil funding to help raise attainment for disadvantaged pupils.



Recovery Premium

An additional boost to Pupil Premium to help pupils recover lost learning.



Third Space Learning is a DfE-approved Tuition Partner eligible for the National **Tutoring Programme funding.**

The majority of pupils who receive tuition from Third Space Learning are eligible for Pupil Premium funding.

Ring-fenced grant funding allocated directly to schools for inschool tutoring.

- Available for use on DfE-approved Tuition Partners.
- Third Space Learning is the most affordable DfEapproved one to one tutoring provider.
- Not limited to Pupil Premium pupils.
- Can be used to cover up to 50% of the cost of tutoring sessions in 23/24.
- Must be spent on tutoring and any unspent funding will be recovered at the end of the academic year.

Per-pupil funding to help raise attainment for disadvantaged pupils.

- The DfE has put more emphasis on its use for highly evidenced strategies such as quality first teaching and tutoring for interventions.
- Prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, this is traditionally how most schools have funded their Third Space Learning sessions.
- Can be used to cover the remaining costs of tuition that are not covered by the National Tutoring Programme.

An additional boost to Pupil Premium to help pupils recover lost learning.

- Allocations are based on eligible pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding.
- Not limited to Pupil Premium pupils, it can be used to flexibly support pupils across the schools.
- To be spent on evidence-based approaches to supporting pupils such as tutoring.
- \checkmark Minumum payment of £2,000 per primary school and £6,000 per secondary school.
